Rodney is a founder Director of Design Engine and is currently leading a number of projects including the masterplanning of a major housing project of 350 homes in Southampton. He has also been responsible for a housing project in Guernsey, awarded the Civic Trust Award 2007 for Housing an RIBA Award 2007 and RTPI Commendation in 2008.

Other projects include a number of exemplar BREEAM 'very-good' rated office buildings and an extension project to the historic Examination Schools and Ruskin School of Art for Oxford University (£1.4 m)

Rodney also has considerable experience in the education sector, acting as project architect for the RIBA award-winning £13m Haute Vallee School, Jersey; a project which included a performance theatre, library and sports hall and which was completed in 1998 and designed and monitored as an exemplary low-energy building.

Rodney also teaches at Portsmouth University and Huddersfield University Schools of Architecture and is an RIBA recognised examiner in Professional Practice. He also acts as review director on the Oxford Brookes University projects.
